### OUR WORK & IMPACT

#### ETH's Mpunde Health Center:

Located in Eastern Uganda, Buyende District is one of the most underserved areas in the world, with one physician for a population of over 400,000 people.

Our Ugandan clinical staff provides healthcare for 54 villages and over 70,000 rural villagers who otherwise would not have access to care. To date, we have treated over 30,000 patients, which means a significant portion of the district has been touched by our work!

#### Mental Health Services:

ETH currently employs the only mental health specialist in Buyende District. We have developed novel interventions to reduce mental health stigma and conduct group therapy sessions for mothers struggling with depression.

#### Research:

ETH has published a multitude of research papers in world-class, peer-reviewed scientific journals that describe novel, high-impact, scalable solutions in key areas of global health
